1. Welcome and Opening

2. Approval of Minutes of 2016 General Assembly

Approved.

3. Chairmans Report

Gerhard Lakemeyer reported that the ECAI 2016 final budget had been finalised, essentially at break-even. He reported on his attendance at two EU meetings in Brussels. Firstly on January 26 which was a "Consultation Meeting on AI" chaired by Cecille Huet. The second on June 27 was entitled "Science is Global" with Clare Moody, MEP, and Royal Society, UK.

4. Treasurers Report

Gerhard Lakemeyer presented the EurAI Treasurer's Report that was prepared by the Steven Schockaert.

5. EurAI Fellows 2017

Gerhard Lakemeyer reported on the 2017 EurAI Fellows Program. The Chair of the 2017 Fellows Selection Committee was Hector Geffner. The following five were selected as Fellows from a list of ten nominations:

6. EurAI Dissertation Award

Barry O'Sullivan, Chair of the 2016 Dissertation Award Selection Committee, reported

on the selection process and the awards. There were 9 submissions. Winner: Gabriele Valentini for “The Best-of-n Problem in Robot Swarms”. Honourable mention to Riccardo Zese: “Probabilistic reasoning and Learning for the Semantic Web”.

7. EurAI Sponsored Conferences

There are two open calls per year for sponsoring EurAI invited speakers at conferences. In addition, the following conferences were sponsored in 2017: RuleML/RR, LPNMR, AIME, TARK, DL, ITP, TABLEAUX, EASS, CADE, ECML/PKDD, CP/ILP/SAT, ISWC, IJCAI, ICCBR, GanDALF.

8. ACAI 2017 and 2018

The 2017 ACAI Summer School will focus on Reinforcement Learning and will be held from October 7-14, 2017 in Nieuwpoort, Belgium. As usual, EurAI sponsors student travel and invited speakers. Details can be found at <https://ai.vub.ac.be/ssr12017>

The EurAI board also accepted a bid for an ACAI school in 2018. This will focus on Statistical Relational Artificial Intelligence and will be held on 27-31 August 2018 at the University of Ferrara, Italy. The organizers are Kristian Kersting, Marco Lippi, Sriraam Natarajan and Fabrizio Riguzzi.

9. IJCAI/ECAI 2018 Status Update

An update on the IJCAI-ECAI 2018 conference was presented by Jeff Rosencild. The presentation was very well received.

There was a general note of concern that IJCAI-ECAI would overlap with FLOC 2018 in Oxford.

10. Engagement in European Programmes

Barry O’Sullivan briefed the meeting of ongoing activities in Brussels that he was leading on behalf of EurAI. Working closely with the European Commission, an event to bring together the EurAI member associations with representatives of the Commission, industry, and governments, is being arranged. It is expected that this event will run in the early new year. The purpose is to ensure that European Commission officials are aware of EurAI, its scale, and significance.

11. Future ECAI Conferences

ECAI 2022 will again be joint with IJCAI with a Call for Bids issued at the end of the year. Decisions will be taken at IJCAI/ECAI 2018

A discussion also took place about whether ECAI should become an annual conference. There was unanimous agreement that this would not be worthwhile. **Approved.**
